Final year degree students (16) Field visits give opportunities for students to enjoy experiential learning. Students really utilized the opportunity Head of the department Dr. Manisha Bhatkulkar, accompanied with two CHB teachers Mr. Sumit Gurchal and Mrs. and teachers accompanied the team. 		<p>from Dr. Kulkarni Employee at college of fishery science, for visit on <b>05 October 2023</b> for Students of Final year B.Sc. Zoology and accompanying teachers reached the centre by conveyance arranged from department.</p> <p>The College of Fishery Science and Fish Seed Production centre is situated at Telangkhedi, in Nagpur. We have firstly enrolled the names of the students by paying amount of 40/- Rs per student then first of all students visit the Fish Museum where more than 100 Specimens of Various fishes were preserved included freshwater organisms kept in glass jars ,like fishes <i>Catla</i> ,<i>Rohu</i> ,<i>Mrigal</i>, <i>Tilapia</i>, <i>Sting ray</i>, <i>Pompret</i>, <i>Mytus</i>, <i>Channa</i>, <i>Prawns</i> etc.</p> <p>Then, Dr. .Kulkarni Sir had given the information of working Chinese Hatchery System and also explained the complete process of Chinese hatchery. He also highlighted the basic concepts regarding stocking pond, rearing pond, fry, spawn and fingerlings to students. From there we moved on to see the fish farm and also watched the live fish catching by using drag net. Here, students also gets the experience of touching the scales of fishes like <i>Catla</i>, <i>Mrigal</i>, <i>Rohu</i>. Dr.Kulkarni sir explained the functioning and the rearing of common carps. He also give tips regarding identification of male and female fishes. Collection of zooplankton was also shown practically by experts of zooplankton culture. In the end, Mr.Sumit Gurchal CHB Teacher proposed vote of thanks on behalf of Department of Zoology &amp; Jawaharlal Nehru Arts, Commerce and Science College Wadi ,Nagpur to Mr. Kulkarni sir and co. of College of Fishery Science for their permission to visit and enlightened students with fruitful knowledge. This field visit was a really interesting and motivating one. We are very thankful to our Principal Dr. Sanjay Tekade Sir for permitting us to visit the fish farm.</p>

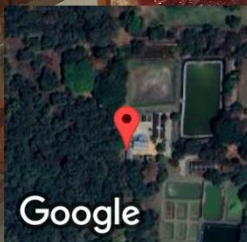
