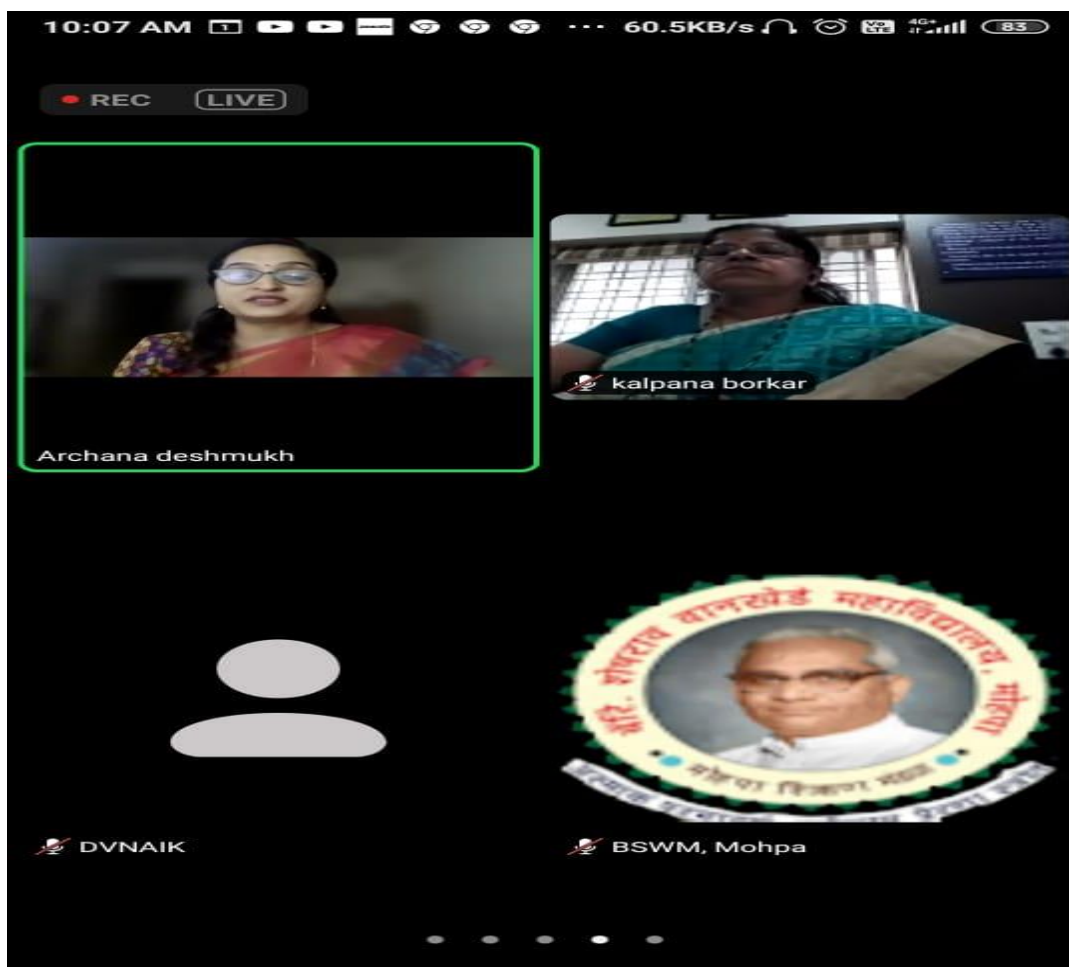

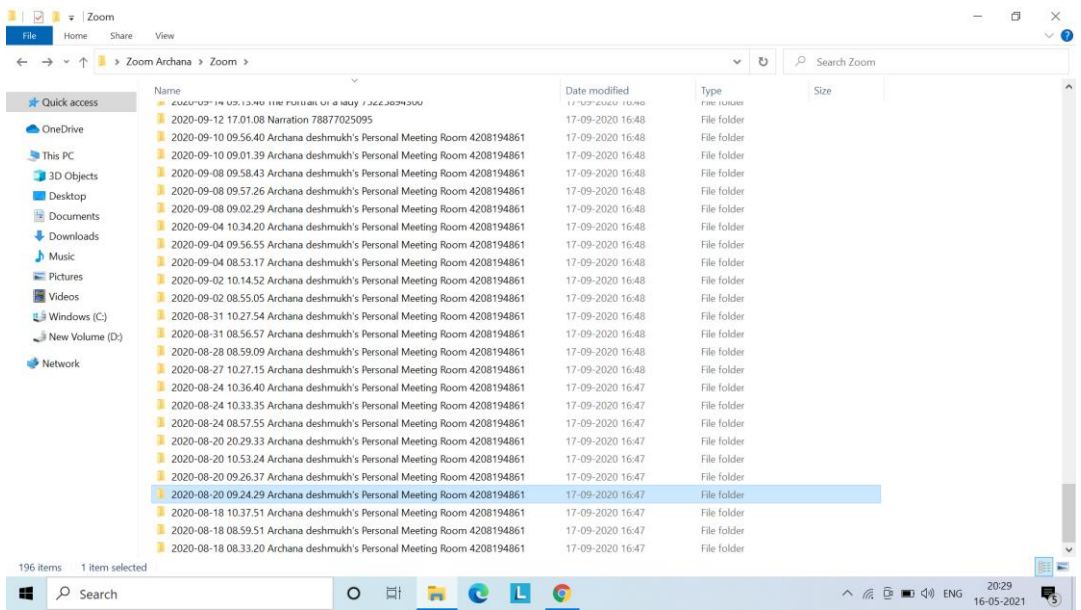
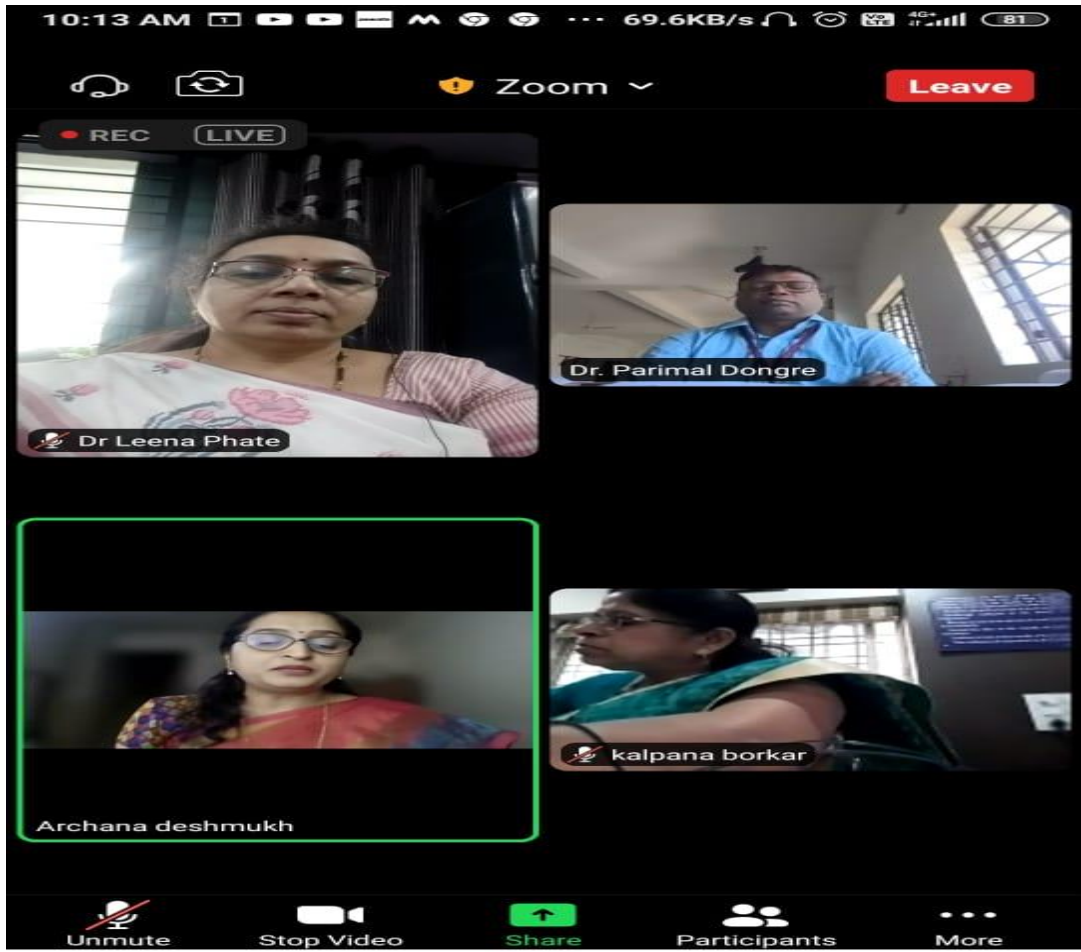
Report of use of ICT Tools:
