Introduction to Intellectual Property: The workshop begin with an overview of what intellectual property is and its various forms, such as patents, trademarks, copyrights, and trade secrets.

Importance of Intellectual Property: Emphasis on the importance of protecting intellectual property for individuals, organizations, and the economy.

Types of Intellectual Property Rights:

Patents: Explanation of the patent system, the process of obtaining a patent, and its benefits.

Trademarks: Understanding the role of trademarks in branding and their registration process.

Copyrights: Exploring the realm of copyrights, including the protection of creative works and copyright registration.

Industrial Design: An industrial design is the ornamental or aesthetic aspect of an article which must appeal to the eye. The design may consist of three-dimensional features, such as the shape or surface of an article, or of two-dimensional features, such as patterns, lines or color.


Geographical Indication: Geographical Indication is an indication which identifies goods as agricultural goods, natural goods or manufactured goods as originating, or manufactured in the territory of country, or a region or locality in that territory, where a given quality, reputation or other characteristic of such goods is essentially attributable to its geographical origin.

1) Patents:

Law: Patents Act, 1970; Patents (Amendment) Act, 2005; Patents Rules, 2003; Patent (Amendment) Rules, 2020

Relevant Ministry: Office of the Controller General of Patents, Designs and

Trade Marks (Indian Patent Office), Department for Promotion of Industry and

Internal Trade (DPIIT), Ministry of Commerce and industry

According to the Patents Act, 1970, an 'invention' must fulfil three criteria:

- It must be a new product or a process that did not previously exist
- It must offer a new technical improvement as simple changes to a previously known technique cannot be patented
- The proposed invention must be useful

Patent Registration procedure:

- ➤ Patentability Search
- > Drafting the patent application
- Filing a patent application
- ➤ Publication of application
- Examination of application
- Objection by the examiner
- Office action response
- Grant of patent registration
